

Great North Air Ambulance Charity Golf Day (Event) Terms and conditions (Terms)

- 1. To attend the event (subject to availability) you must pay the £340.00 non-refundable fee (Team Price).
- 2. The Team Price is for 4 members and includes breakfast roll and tea/coffee, 18 holes of golf and a two-course dinner.
- 3. Additional non-playing guests may attend the two-course dinner at a cost of £30.
- 4. Any attendee under the age of 18 must be accompanied to the event by an adult. Due to the nature of the event, attendees must be aged 12 years or over.
- 5. If you are unable to attend, you may send a substitute at no extra cost. If possible, please notify us of the change prior to the event.
- 6. Once booked, we are unable to offer cancellations or refunds, should you change your mind about attending.
- 7. Due to circumstances beyond our control, we reserve the right to cancel the event or change the venue/date/time. In this case, we will refund the full ticket price if required. However, we will not be liable for any other costs incurred by attendees.
- 8. All additional costs related to the event including, but not limited to, travel and accommodation are the responsibility of the attendees.
- 9. The organisers are not liable for any injury, damage or loss other than in respect of death or personal injury arising as a result of the organisers' negligence.
- 10. Attendees of the event agree to be filmed/photographed and for their images used in publicity for the event and future events by the Great North Air Ambulance Service (GNAAS).
- 11. We reserve the right to refuse admission and eject anyone as deemed necessary.

Golf Day Etiquette

- Visitors are expected to give consideration to other players, to safety on the course and the pace of play.
- Golfers must repair pitch markers and replace divots.
- Normal Golf club dress codes apply. Denim jeans, combat trousers and non-golf apparel shirts are not permitted.
- Tailored shorts may be worn
- Golf shoes with soft spikes are allowed only, Rockliffe Hall can change metal spikes on the day at a small charge

Buggy & Trolley policy

- A limited number of buggies are available on a first come, first served basis. To book, phone the Pro Shop on 01325 729980
- Buggy usage is subject to weather and course conditions
- Buggies must be kept to fairways and paths where possible. Golfers found driving in the long rough will be asked to leave their buggy and walk the remainder of their round with no refund.

Handicaps & Standard of Play

Evidence of handicap certificate is not mandatory, however the minimum requirement for all golfers is to be able to play at a standard of no worse than 28 handicap (men), 36 (ladies.
